Learn about your benefits

An Independence Blue Cross (IBX) health plan gives you everything you need to take care of your health and well-being. To get the most out of your plan, it's important to know how your benefits work and where to find information.

Here are some good places to start:



Coverage and benefits information

Log in at ibx.com and select *My Benefits* from the Coverage & Benefits menu on the left side of your Dashboard. You'll find an overview of your benefits, an option to search for a particular service, and more detailed Plan Documents. One of these documents is your Benefits Booklet, which explains how to use your health plan and has a complete schedule of benefits and exclusions.



Member ID card

Be sure to present your member ID card anytime you receive care. You can also add your ID card to your phone's wallet using the IBX mobile app. Your ID card contains valuable information, including:

- Your unique member ID number
- What you'll pay for certain services
- Any deductibles or out-of-pocket maximums your plan has
- Phone numbers you can use to contact us



Explanation of benefits (EOB)

An EOB is like an itemized receipt for care you receive. It shows how much the provider charged, what your health plan covered, and how much (if anything) you'll pay out of pocket. Keep in mind that an EOB isn't a bill. If you owe anything, your provider will send you a bill.

Get the care you need, when you need it

With a POS health plan, you have flexibility when choosing where to get care. Here are some key things to know.



Primary care physician (PCP)

You must choose an in-network PCP to treat your general health needs, coordinate your care, and refer you to specialists when necessary. Log in at ibx.com to select a PCP for you and any dependents on your health plan.



Specialist

You have the option to self-refer to any doctor, but you'll get the highest level of benefits with a referral from your PCP for an in-network specialist. Some services don't require referrals, including gynecology, mammograms, behavioral health, and emergency care. Log in at ibx.com to check the status of a referral.



Designated sites

Your PCP has designated providers for lab services (e.g., blood tests), radiology (e.g., X-rays), and physical and occupational therapy. Be sure to visit those designated providers when you need any of these services. A referral or prescription may also be necessary. You can view your PCP's designated providers by logging in at ibx.com.



Out-of-network benefits

You have the option to self-refer to both in- and out-of-network providers, but you will pay more in out-of-pocket costs. You get the highest level of benefits by asking your PCP to refer you to in-network specialists.



Precertification

Precertification is an approval your doctor must receive from us before you get coverage for certain services, genetic tests, and specialty drugs. Visit ibx.com/precert for a complete list of what requires precertification.

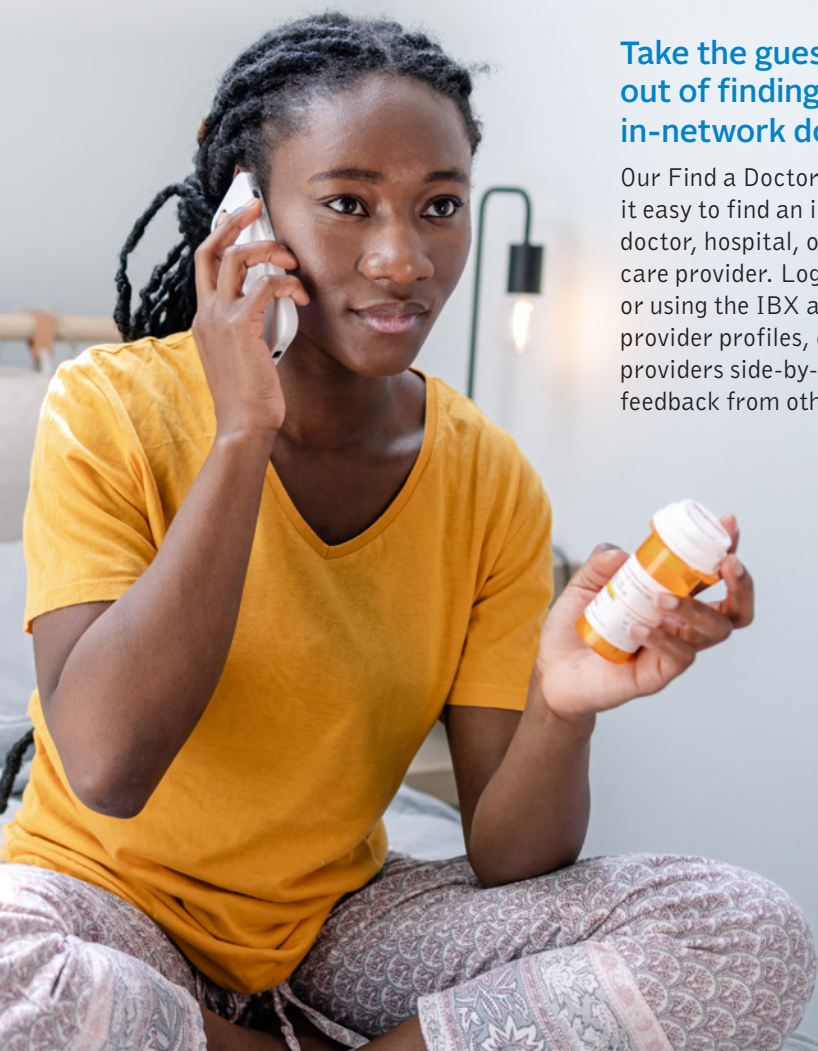


Virtual care

Most health plans include convenient and affordable virtual care options so you can talk to a doctor by phone or video chat. Refer to your benefits summary to see your virtual care options. Effective May 1, 2025, the 1199c Fund is adding behavioral health and dermatology coverage to the Teladoc Health virtual care benefit for a \$30 specialist copay.

Behavioral health resources and support

We want to make it easier to take care of your mental health. That's why we make sure our members have a variety of support and care options.

Finding care

Call the Mental Health number on the back of your member ID card to reach our Behavioral Health team, who can help you find an in-network behavioral health provider and can even schedule an appointment for you — usually for within a week. During tough times, we can also connect you with our Care Management team for in-the-moment support.

Another way to find in-network behavioral health care is by using Quartet, a service that will match you to an in-network provider who fits your needs and preferences. quartethealth.com/ibx

For members who need substance use disorder support, Shatterproof Treatment Atlas is a free online tool that can help you find in-network addiction treatment. treatmentatlas.org

Virtual care and digital resources

Virtual care is convenient, affordable, and confidential. Many in-network providers offer virtual services in addition to in-person. Or schedule a virtual appointment with a licensed psychiatrist, psychologist, or therapist from the Teladoc Health (Teladoc) network. teladochealth.com

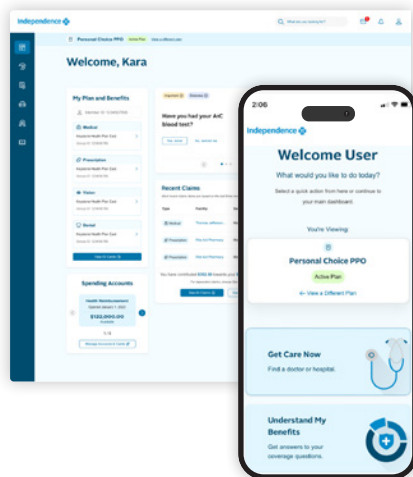
